At Navico Group, I work closely with UI/UX designers and developers to deliver accessible, performant websites across our portfolio of B2C brands. Early in my role, I helped design and implement a shared component library and led a rebuild of our CMS platform using Optimizely. The new system enables marketing teams to create and manage brand websites without developer input or production deployments, accelerating delivery times by over 70%.

After the success of those projects, I was invited to lead the Front End refactor of our flagship brand site, Del City. This involved modernising legacy code to meet WCAG level AA standards and support stronger organic SEO all while preserving the site's original visual design. The updated site is currently in testing and scheduled to launch in July.

More recently, I've taken on the redevelopment of Lowrance, one of our largest e-commerce sites. Built with Optimizely CMS and Commerce, the project includes hundreds of products and complex templates. I'm focused on delivering a future ready, accessible front end that supports scalability, improved performance, and seamless product management.
